

CHANGED TRAFFIC CONDITIONS

Peninsula Link Project

August 2010

CRANBOURNE ROAD, FRANKSTON - FROM AUGUST 2010 UNTIL EARLY 2013

To accommodate the construction of Peninsula Link, changed traffic conditions are required on Cranbourne Road that will impact travel between McClelland Drive and Ferndale Drive, Frankston (Melway Ref: 103 D5). The works include construction of a full diamond interchange and bridge on the existing Cranbourne Road alignment to allow Peninsula Link to pass under the road.

The following changes will come into effect from early August 2010 and continue until early 2013:

- A speed reduction from 80 km/h to 60 km/h through the construction zone for the duration of the works
- The path along the northern side of Cranbourne Road will be retained as a shared use path
- The westbound bus stop outside Peninsula Private Hospital may potentially be relocated to east of McClelland Drive and appropriate signage will be installed
- Traffic will be diverted onto a temporary side track with four travelling lanes and a shared use path south of the existing road alignment.

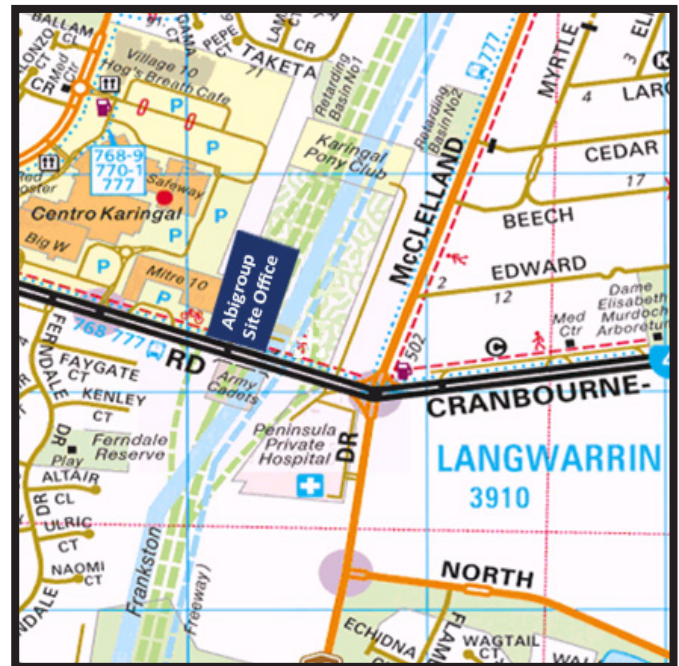
With Peninsula Link construction now underway there will be an increase in traffic particularly on Cranbourne Road, Frankston where light and heavy construction vehicles will access Abigroup's site office (refer to map at right).

Vehicle movements will be strictly monitored. Although access to the site office may occur at any time, construction works are generally undertaken Monday to Friday between 7am and 6pm and on Saturdays between 7am and 4pm with occasional out of hours works as required.

In accordance with the Project Environmental Management Plan, Abigroup has measures in place to assist in reducing construction impacts, including:

- Road sweepers on local roads and water trucks to suppress dust on the site and access tracks
- Covering loads on trucks moving outside of work sites and monitoring vehicle movements and speeds
- Conducting regular 'toolbox talks' with the crews and sub-contractors about safety and construction impacts.
